Inside: the main entrance takes one into a compact, bright, open-plan space with a dining table and a sofa in front of a designer fireplace. On the sea-facing side, large sliding glass doors open out onto a decked terrace and the gardens, ensuring a seamless indoor-outdoor lifestyle for guests.

On the other side of the fireplace, which is inserted into a concrete partition wall, is the modern, well-equipped galley-style kitchen. It too has glass doors accessing the main al fresco dining area on the decked terrace.

An opening at one side of the kitchen takes one into the compact sleeping wing, which comprises two double bedrooms, a cosy kids’ bunk-bed room and two shared shower rooms. One of the doubles and the bunk room have access to a secluded, pine tree-shaded courtyard, while one of the bathrooms boasts a porthole in the shower, offering views of the gardens and sea beyond.

Outside: Euridice is enveloped in mature, beautifully tended gardens. From a shady pine copse at the front, paths lead around to the sea-facing side of the property, which is home to a decked terrace, furnished for al fresco dining and lounging, and an expanse of manicured lawn.

Magnetic sea views entice one to the end of the gardens where there is a tree-shaded terrace with a perfectly positioned hammock. An aloe vera-flanked path with steps leads down from here, past a panoramic sitting area suspended above the sea, to the private sea access. Here, a detachable ladder connects two rocky platforms. The upper level is furnished for sun-bathing, while the latter, like a partially submerged edge of an infinity pool, gives way to the translucent waters of Guidaloca bay.

CONSIDERATIONS

Please note that the sea access is via a path of around 80 steps and a detachable 3m-high (approx.) ladder. Access to the water itself is via rocks and might not be possible if the sea is rough. We urge caution at all times.

EXPLORING THE LOCAL AREA

Set on the coast of Guidaloca bay, between the Golfo di Castellammare and the nature reserve of Lo Zingaro, Euridice occupies a prime spot on one of the most beautiful and striking stretches of coastline in Sicily.

The small village of **Scopello** just up the hill has a good selection of restaurants and bars, and can be reached by car in about 5 minutes. There is also a mini-market (with excellent deli, butcher's and wine selection), a good bar and an organic farm shop selling superb fruit and vegetables about 5 minutes drive away (or 15mins walk) on the road towards Scopello.

The old tuna fishery (*tonnara*) of Scopello, about a 5-minute drive away, occupies a very suggestive setting, and **Lo Zingaro Nature Reserve** offers a range of spectacular walks and some beautiful crystal clear bays for swimming. There is a diving centre in Scopello for SCUBA lovers and a pebbly beach with equipped lidos just a couple of minutes drive away at Guidaloca beach.

The town of **Castellammare del Golfo** a few kilometres east along the coast has several seafront bars and restaurants, a daily fish market and a long sandy beach.

The spectacular Elymian/Greek site of **Segesta** is about 30 minutes' drive away and **Erice, Palermo, Trapani** and **Selinunte** can all be reached in under an hour.

You could also swim there from the villa's sea access.

Nearest shops and restaurants: 1.2km along the road towards Scopello village and in Scopello itself, a 5-minute drive.

Please note that It is possible to walk to the mini-market and bar and Guidaloca beach but there are no pavements and some sections of the road are unilluminated.

Castellammare del Golfo (shops and beach): 10-15mins drive

Zingaro Nature Reserve: 5mins drive

Segesta: 30km-18miles-30mins

Erice: 35km-22miles-45mins

Selinunte: 70km-44miles-55mins

Palermo/Monreale: 75km-47miles-1hr
